

STATEMENT

WEEE directive

This statement is for positioners and switch boxes.

WEEE = waste electrical and electronic equipment (Directive 2012/19/EU)

The purpose of the Directive was to set targets for the collection, recovery and recycling of waste electrical and electronic equipment across Europe and divert volumes of waste electrical equipment from landfill. The legislation places the liability on producers to be responsible for their items when they become waste.

Products designed and produced by PMV Automation AB are exempt from the requirements set by the WEEE directive.

The reasons are:

- Article 2 Scope, paragraph 4 (c)
 - 4) In addition to the equipment specified in paragraph 3, from 15 August 2018, this Directive shall not apply to the following EEE:
 - c) large-scale fixed installations, except any equipment which is not specifically designed and installed as part of those installations;
- Article 3 Definitions, paragraph 1 (c)
 - 1) For the purposes of this Directive, the following definitions shall apply:
 - c. large-scale fixed installation' means a large-size combination of several types of apparatus and, where applicable, other devices, which:
 - i. are assembled, installed and de-installed by professionals;
 - ii. are intended to be used permanently as part of a building or a structure at a pre-defined and dedicated location; and
 - iii. can only be replaced by the same specifically designed equipment;
